




WHO WE ARE?


We are a non-profit association from Hunedoara (C.I.F. 47723560/ 28.02.2023), with members who love the mountains and mountain sports, as well as dozens of volunteers from everywhere. Our founders, who materialized our energies are loan Moldovan and Mihai Cherciov, both of whom are regularly present in Râușor resort, Hunedoara county.

We have a sustained activity, through volunteer projects in the Park area Retezat National, our operational center being located in Râușor. We organized so far numerous actions to recondition the tourist markings and sanitize the routes in Retezat Mountains.

But our soul project is Retezat Mountain Run, an event we we will organize for its second edition on August 10, 2024.

We take over the tradition of 10 years interrupted in 2020 by Retezat Maraton and we promise an exceptional event, with many other editions in the years to come.









FROM RETEZAT MARATHON TO RMR

The Retezat Mountain Run concept, initiated in 2023, introduced a new team with extensive experience in organizing similar events, marking a successful rebranding and laying out a continuity plan for the next five years.

We are currently reinventing the traditional 10-year-old event, Retezat Marathon, the sole competition challenging the greatness of its namesake peak.

We will ensure the event's organization with the assistance of dedicated volunteers, overseen by professionals specially co-opted for the race's success. Our aim is to elevate mountain running to the highest level, as it rapidly matures as a phenomenon.

We take pride in stating that for many of us, along with our friends and athletes alike, running in Retezat was a revelation that inspired us to participate in a series of other mountain races.

Regardless of competitors' goals or their training levels on race day, all our races provide the opportunity to experience the serenity and splendor of the Retezat Massif.

All races will commence from the Râușor resort, located at the base of the ski slope. Both the Marathon and Half Marathon share a common route that ascends to Retezat Peak, where the first support station will be located. From there, both races proceed to Lake Bucura, where the primary support station for the competition is situated.

The start of all races will be in the resort Râusor, at the base of the ski slope. Both the Marathon and Half Marathon courses share a route that traverses Retezat Peak, where the first support point will be located. From there, both races continue to Lake Bucura, which hosts the most crucial support station of the competition.

The cross leaves through Stevia Valley, reaching Retezat Peak and descending on Preluce Peak to Râușor.

CROSS - 12.8km/1260m HALFMARATHON - 24.9km/1960m **MARATHON** - 39.7 km/3340m




RMR IN NUMBERS AND THE RACES

CROSS-CROSS

Distance covered 12.8 km, with an elevation gain of 1260m.


From Râușor, the route departs for Refuge Condor - Stevia Valley - Lolaia Saddle - Retezat peak - Preluce peak - Valereasca Ridge - and follows the forest road towards the finish line at the base of the ski slope.



HALF-MARATHON


Distance covered 24.9 km, with an elevation gain of 1960m.

From Râușor, the route follows the forest road to Valereasca Ridge - Preluce Peak - Retezat Peak - Retezat Saddle - under Bucura Peak - lake Taul Porții - Bucura Lake - Bucura Saddle - Pietrele Lake - Pietrelor Valley - Gențiana Chalet - Pietrele Chalet - Stanisoara Valley - Ciurila Ridge - the finish line at the base of the ski slope.



MARATHON

Distance covered 39.7km, with an elevation gain of 3340m. From Râușor, the route follows the forest road to Valereasca Ridge - Preluce Peak - Retezat Peak - Retezat Saddle - under Bucura Peak - lake Taul Porții - Bucura Lake - The Rescue Shelter - Căldarea Berbecilor - Peleaga Peak - Păpușa Peak - under Custura Peak - Plaiul Mic Saddle - Peleaga Glade - Bucura Lake - Bucura Saddle - Pietrele Lake - Pietrele Valley - Gențiana Chalet - Pietrele Chalet - Stanisoara Valley - Ciurila Ridge - the finish line at the base of the ski slope.



RETEZAT MOUNTAIN RUN


If until now you have not realized the magnitude of the RMR operation, we say it now: it is the wildest and most difficult to reach race in Romania. 8 Of the 11 support stations on the route can only be reached by foot or air. Possibly with donkeys or horses.

Obviously we're going to carry everything with our amazing and dedicated volunteers, who will also supervise the safety of the runners.

We do not have a GSM signal, we will totally communicate with the help of the stations. Of course, we are also preparing for bad weather, which at over 2000 meters altitude can overturn any calculation.

WE NEED HELP

Like any community event, we rely on your support. We began with the essential contributions from CLIF ALPIN Râușor Guesthouse, Lolaia Râușor Chalet, and Râusor Ski Resort.

Additionally, any contribution will mark a new milestone in the event's enhancement. From becoming an official partner in the competition to promoting a sponsor's name, we can establish various forms of collaboration.

We will provide participation kits to all participants, along with cash prizes and equipment. Additionally, food and drinks will be available at the start/finish area and the 4 main stations.

Motorized access is available at only one station; for the others, everything will be transported by our dedicated volunteers. While helicopter transport is an option, we can't afford that yet :-)

We also need to mark and secure the entire route, with support from ISU, the mountain rescue teams, and all local authorities, as required.

For exceptional cases, we will keep a private air ambulance and a mountain rescue team on standby. Naturally, all of this involves expenses.
